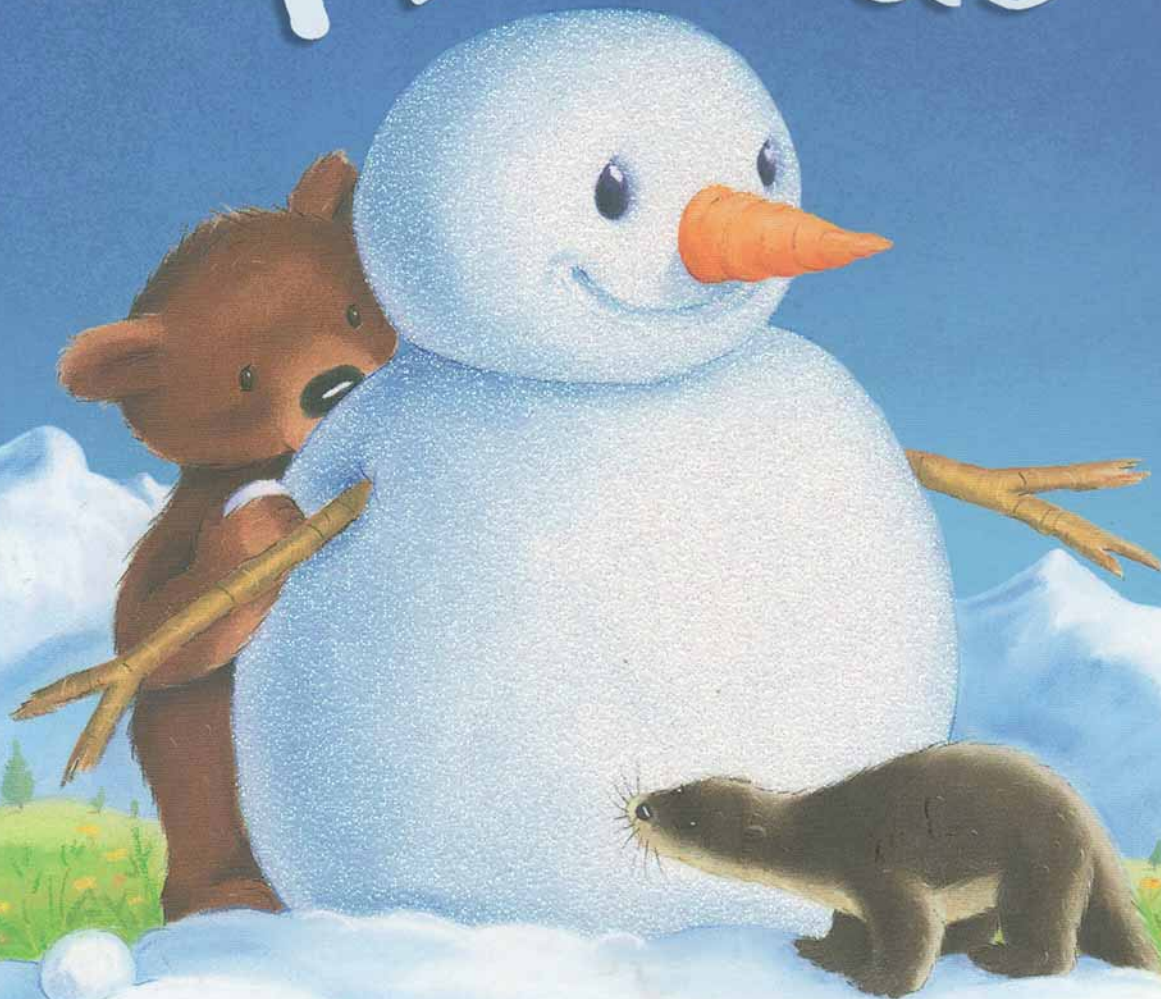


Snow Friends

them giggling and gasping for breath.



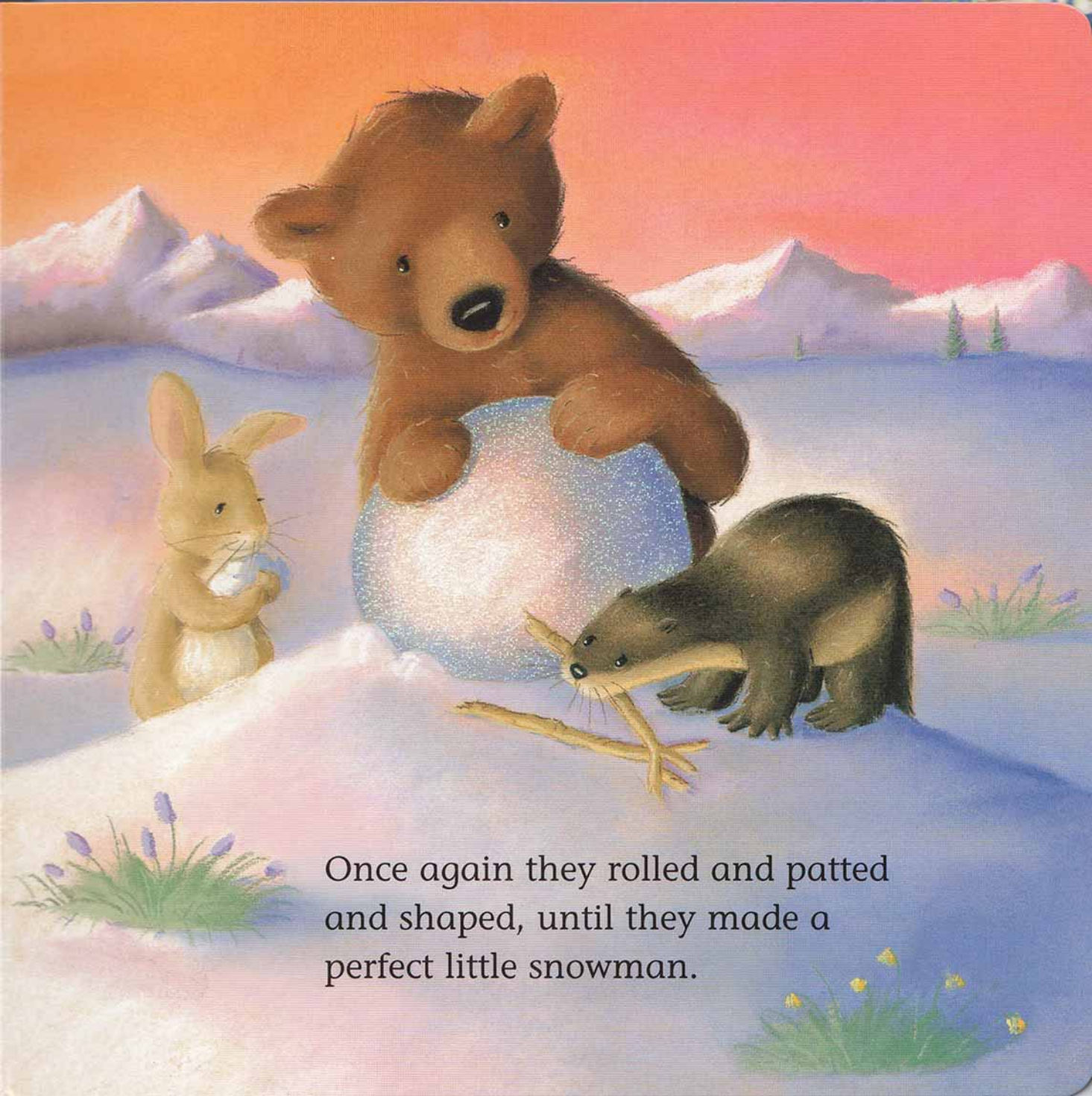
As the sun set, the three friends talked about what games they could play the next day.

“Let’s build him a friend, then!” said Otter.





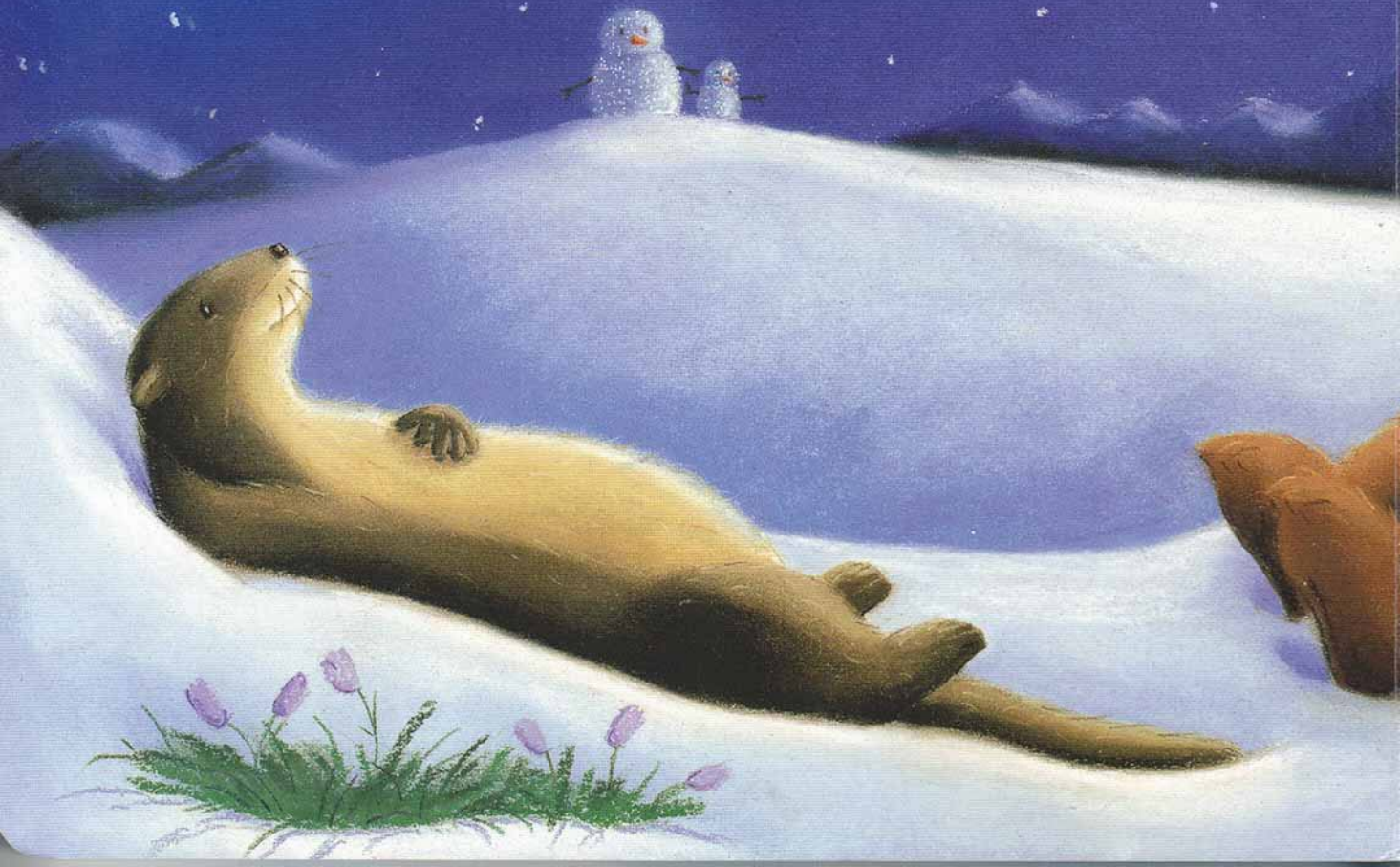
Once again they rolled and patted

Tired and happy they watched as the snowman and his friend turned to silver in the moonlight.


“He’s the BESTEST SNOWMAN IN THE WORLD,”
